ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A Bachelor's Degree


For all the Masters programmes, a Bachelor's degree with good performance, in any field is required.

Good knowledge of English

Postgraduate applicants must have advanced knowledge of the English language certified by:

- International English Language Testing System (IELTS Academic) with overall score of 6.5 or above, with at least 5.5 in each component.
- Pearson PTE Academic with overall score 61 or above, with no less than 51 in each component.
- Cambridge Certificate in Advanced English (CAE) with overall score of 176 or above, with no less than 162 in each component.
- Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE) with an overall score of 176 or above, with no less than 162 in each component.
- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) internet-based test (iBT) and special home edition, with overall score 87 or above, with a minimum of 17 in Listening, 18 in Reading, 20 in Speaking and 17 in Writing.
- Michigan State University Certificate of English Language Proficiency (MSU CELP): CEFR C2
- GCSE English Language with minimum Grade C / Grade 4.
- iGCSE English Language with minimum Grade C.
- Trinity ISE Level 3 with Pass in all components.
- Duolingo with overall score 110, minimum 90 in all other components.
- Examination for the Certificate of Proficiency in English (ECPE).
- Michigan English Language Assessment Battery (MELAB): overall score 91 and above with a minimum of 81 in writing, listening and GCVR and a minimum of 3- in speaking (accepted until July 2020).
- Michigan English Test (MET): overall score 230 and above with a minimum of 53 in each component.
- Oxford Placement Test (CEFR level of C1 or C2)





The above qualifications should normally have been acquired **within the last three (3) years**, taking into consideration the starting date of the course.



Candidates who have completed their Bachelor's studies or their higher secondary education through the medium of the English Language will not normally need to provide other evidence of English language ability (a document of proof should be submitted e.g. a transcript or letter from the institution).

Admission interview (face-to-face or online)

All applicants are required to sit in the admissions interview which is assessed. Once the application and required documents are complete, candidates will be contacted by the admissions staff of Romanian-American University for the interview arrangement.


You can visit the online admissions platform of the Romanian-American University at https://admission.rau.ro in order to fill in the application form and upload the required documents as provided below (depending on the category you belong).

A. Application documents for non-EU applicants

- An application form, included in the online admission platform from CITY College, University of York Europe Campus to be uploaded in the platform
- Two reference letters*
- Final certificate of studies certified by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Education and the Romanian Embassy / Hague Apostille
- Transcript of records the document that states the subjects learned and the grades obtained in the university years
- High School Graduation Diploma stating your overall average grade that would allow you to pursue Higher Education in your own country and the Bachelor Diploma, certified by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Education and the Romanian Embassy / Hague Apostille
- Birth certificate
- Document showing your permanent residence abroad (with full address) if you do not have one, please contact the local authorities
- Travel Document Passport/Travel Paper/National ID etc. according to applicable laws and regulations of transit
- Medical Certificate stating your medical ability to undergo studies at the University and the fact that you are not a carrier for any known contagious diseases of illnesses
- 1 electronic, clear head photograph (3×5, passport style) in JPG/PNG format
- An approved English language qualification

Please note that all documents should be either in English or Romanian. For documents in other languages, certified translations into English should be provided. All documents should be authentic copies of the originals. Authentication should be obtained at the Romanian Embassy/Consulate (for the study certificates) or by legalizing at your local notary (for the other documents).





B. Application documents for EU/RO applicants with studies outside Romania


- An application form, included in the online admission platform from CITY College, University of York Europe Campus to be uploaded in the platform
- Two reference letters*
- Bachelor's diploma— certified translation into Romanian (electronically signed by notary) if issued in other languages than Romanian/English/French/Italian/Spanish, apostilled or superlegalized and a certified translation into English
- CNRED certificate or CNRED Application form (for those who don't have the CNRED certificate vet)
- Proof of payment of CNRED fee if applicable (for those who don't have the CNRED certificate vet)
- Transcript of records of all university years —certified translation into Romanian (electronically signed by notary) if issued in other languages than Romanian/English/French/Italian/Spanish, apostilled or superlegalized and a certified translation into English
- High school diploma

- Personal identification documents: passport/ID and proof of name change (if applicable)
- Birth certificate, copy
- Medical certificate issued by the family doctor or medical offices (school or territorial) showing that the applicant is fit to take university courses
- 1 electronic, clear head photograph (3×5, passport style) in JPG/PNG format
- An approved English language qualification

c. Application documents for RO applicants with studies in the Romanian educational system

- An application form, included in the online admission platform from CITY College, University of York Europe Campus to be uploaded in the platform
- Two reference letters*
- Bachelor's diploma (copy and certified translation into English)
- Transcript of records of all university years (copy and certified translation into English)
- High school diploma or equivalent with transcripts from all high school years
- Birth certificate
- Marriage certificate (if applicable)
- Health certificate (in an international language) issued by the family doctor or by (school or local)
 medical practices, which acknowledges that the person who is about to register for the studies
 does not suffer from a contagious disease or any other conditions incompatible with their future
 profession
- 1 electronic, clear head photograph (3×5, passport style) in JPG/PNG format





- Identity card or Passport
- An approved English language qualification

*Two Reference Letters

Reference letters can be sent by email to: international@rau.ro directly by the referees.

Reference letters should be written by people who have supervised you in an academic, employment, or community setting. If possible, at least one should be from a university professor who is familiar with your academic work.

Registration fee

The registration fee is a one-time fee paid by all applicants. Applicants will be required to pay the registration fee through an online payment system in the online admissions platform of the Romanian-American University at https://admission.rau.ro
