VISA

Non-EU/EEA students are responsible for getting a study visa prior to entering Romania.

RAU will apply to the Ministry of National Education for the Letter of Acceptance / Approval for studies.

RESIDENCE PERMIT

After arrival, both EU/EEA and non-EU/EEA students must apply for a registration certificate/ residence permit at the Immigration Office in Bucharest in 2-month time. It will take 30 days for the residence permit to be issued. Application support from the Erasmus+ office.

MANDATORY HEALTH INSURANCE

For EU/EEA students, European Health Card or a valid health insurance is necessary.

Non EU/EEA students must have a valid health insurance.
