WHAT I DON'T KNOW ^{AND} I SHOULD KNOW

Romania is a country where citizens are safe.

However, it is important to be aware of the potential risks, to

know how one can avoid risky situations when you can become vulnerable and where you can address in case of emergency.

HOW TO BE SAFE IN ROMANIA

- Stay in authorized hotel establishments verified on official websites
- Use official taxis or shared transport services to avoid scams or unsafe transport.
- Exchange money only at authorized banks or exchange offices
- Be careful where you withdraw money from
- Carry valuables in a safe place separate from identification documents
- Be cautious when approached by strangers, don't give out personal information or agree to go somewhere with someone you don't know
- Be aware of who and what is going on around you at all times, especially in crowded areas or unfamiliar neighborhoods

REMEMBER!

Driving vehicles under the influence of alcohol or psychoactive substances is prohibited in Romania!

If you or someone you know is experiencing an overdose or any other drug-related or non-drug-related medical emergency, it is important to seek immediate help by calling the single emergency number 112. Medical emergencies may include difficulty breathing, confusion or loss of consciousness.

HOW TO PARTY SAFELY

- Be careful how you choose your places of entertainment.
- Clubs are designed to stimulate your senses, so focus on sensory experiences.
- Socialize, enjoy the experience of being around others, but beware of your limits.
- Avoid conflicts, consume alcohol in moderation, hydrate yourself.

REMEMBER!

Drugs are substances that have different effects on one's body - some are stimulants - increase energy and alertness, while others are depressants - slow down the central nervous system.

LEGAL INFORMATION:

- The possession of illegal drugs in Romania is a crime and is punishable
- Drug trafficking is a serious crime in Romania.
- It is forbidden to knowingly make available a home, premises or any other space arranged for the consumption of drugs.
- The introduction or removal of drugs from the country is punishable.
- The Witness Protection Program can provide you with the protection you need if you witness or have knowledge of a crime and are afraid to cooperate with the authorities.
- Both witnesses and family members or people close to them can benefit from protection and assistance measures.

It is essential to know the Romanian legislation because ignorance of the law does not save you from the consequences of not complying with it.
